The Ladder of Inference *in Action*

1	Observe	Alex walked by me this morning and didn't say hello.
2	Select	I noticed Alex looked at their phone instead of at me.
3	Meanings	Alex was ignoring me on purpose.
4	Assumptions	Alex must be upset with me.
5	Conclusions	Alex is holding a grudge over our disagreement last week.
6	Beliefs	Alex is passive-aggressive and unprofessional.
7	Action	I decide to avoid Alex in meetings and not share project updates with them.
